# MEETING REPORT: -Attendance.

Twenty-four members and a pair of 'Joans' (Veerhuis and Page—guests of Peter and Gerry) assembled at the designated meeting point for our special meeting at the Pomingalarna Cycling Complex on Wednesday instead of the usual Thursday. Asset Integrity Officer at Wagga Wagga City Council, **Rob Owers**, was on hand to take us on a tour of this impressive facility.



# The Tour:



The complex, on the city's western outskirts, was completed in April 2022 and is the largest multisport cycling complex in NSW, capable of hosting regional, state, national and international events. A collaboration between Wagga Wagga's cycling groups and the Wagga Wagga City Council, the project attracted a \$7 million grant from the NSW Government's Regional Sports Infrastructure Fund. The facility caters for both competitive and recreational cyclists, providing the Riverina with a world-class venue for cycling activities and elite events which is accessible by everyone.

Rob explained the layout and function of the various tracks that riders can utilise:

- Velodrome track, (which is of Olympic size),
- Criterium track,
- BMX track,
- Jump Tracks,
- Pump Tracks,
- Cycling Education Area and the
- Mountain Bike Playground Loop.

There is literally something for cyclists of all ages and skill levels. Rob introduced us to **Jeff Windsor**, current President of the Wagga Cycling



Club, who told us of their move from the Cricket Ground and the benefit they are gaining from

improved facilities, including a canteen during meetings, and safe storage for the range of bikes which they maintain for hire to cyclists. We finished our tour of the complex with an inspection of the substantial facilities building, with covered viewing area, toilets, change rooms, a canteen and large bike storage/workshop. The

complex has received very favourable comments from visitors taking part in events. The Club is looking forward to its next major event later this month.

Holding our meeting on Wednesday night at the complex enabled us to see the facility in action, with the Wagga Cycling Club holding their regular *Racing Night* with 'Little Kids', followed by 'Big Kids' and then the Seniors. *Track Training* is held in those categories on Monday nights.

A vote of thanks was given to Geoff and Rob by Graham Russell.





A large contingent of the attendees then proceeded for a meal and fellowship at the nearby Ashmont Inn.






### Administration Matters.
